

## AFTER READING

### Review your notes.

Having a signpost to help you find a key idea or concept is useful. You can use the signposts to help you find a key idea or concept in your notes.

### Incorporate multiple learning strategies.

Read your notes out loud, draw a mind map, and try to think of creative ways to engage your visual learning, verbal learning, and auditory learning. This helps to retain the information into multiple 'storage areas' in the brain, which can help to move beyond memorization and towards understanding.

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### Come up with a game plan.

You don't necessarily have to do your reading in order. You can get an overview of the entire reading assignment and then decide where you want to start. Consider a plan for your reading.
